

COMMUNITY SERVICE UPDATE

Students are able to view their community service hours for the year on Plus Portals > Demographics.

The safety of our JCS families is chiefly important to us; therefore, no students will be penalized for not completing community service for the 19-20 school year. However, any hours that have been submitted or will be submitted will still count toward your community service hours. Your diligent service to the community has not been overlooked and we appreciate all of the time and effort you have contributed to the local and global community this year. It is important that you are mindful of reaching at least 100 total hours for your four years of high school due to Bright Futures requirements.

Please send any community service hours completed prior to our Distance Learning Plan to kcich@jupiterchristian.org as this will still "count" toward your hours. This is specifically important for seniors who need to reach 100 hours for Bright Futures eligibility.

While students will not be penalized for not reaching community service minimums this year, we want to encourage continued kind acts of service from a distance to protect others around us, the community, country and our world. In the spirit of service to others in this difficult time, JCS welcomes students to create projects from home to support those on the front lines. With this in mind, JCS is taking on the following initiative to create masks:

This project has three parts:

- 1. Pick up materials from JCS on 3/31
- 2 Make masks
- 3. Drop off on 4/3 or Mail back

We will then distribute them to our community healthcare & service workers.

It is that easy! You do not even need to sew to make these masks, although we will have sewing machines available for those who need them and prefer to sew.

We will be handing out the bag with kits to make masks on Tuesday 3/31 in the lower school car line from 3PM to 4PM.

You can then drop the masks off to us on Friday 4/3 in the lower school car line from 3PM to 4PM.
