-Safety and health will remain paramount. Social distancing protocols will remain in place (gloves and masks will be worn by all school personnel; no individuals will be permitted to exit their vehicles, etc.).

-We would love to see students as they ride through campus one more time before they head into the summer. :)

-Students, parents, employees, or anyone who exhibits COVID-19 symptoms such as fever of 100 degrees or higher, or may suspect being COVID-19 positive, should not enter campus.

-Items to be brought to school include textbooks (teachers will send emails to students identifying which textbooks must be returned); borrowed band instruments; laptops, iPads, or other loaned technology items; Athletic uniforms; etc.

-Items which will be distributed to students include: yearbooks (for those who have ordered them); Academic Awards to recipients who have earned them; locker items which remained on campus (hallway and gym); medicine held in the clinic; etc.

(Note: Only families picking up medicine and/or picking up instruments or artwork need to go through the West Campus Lower School car line.)

-When dropping off textbooks, be certain your student's name is listed as the bottom name on the inside cover of the book. Books returned should match the book number distributed by the teacher at the beginning of the year.

-Parents' assistance with returning all school items is extremely important in avoiding replacement costs. As we continue to partner with you during these uncertain times, we look for your assistance to keep such costs down. By returning these items, you will help JCS enter the 2020-21 school year with the resources necessary for success. Unreturned items will result in a replacement fee being assessed to your family account.
