DONNA BARTZ MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarship Management

- The Donna Bartz Memorial Scholarship shall be established and maintained by Jupiter Christian School
- Funding shall include, but not be limited to private donors, annual fundraiser led by Bartz family, contributions made by Jupiter Christian staff and faculty, or other contributors.
- The Scholarship application, recipient and reward will be managed by the Donna Bartz Memorial Scholarship Review Committee. The Review Committee shall consist of a minimum of five members which shall include, but not be limited to the surviving spouse (John Bartz) and children (Hannah Bartz, Joshua Bartz, Taylor Bartz), Jupiter Christian elementary teacher, Jupiter Christian Staff administrator or Board member.
- The Scholarship award amount and the number of recipients shall be determined annually by the Donna Bartz Memorial Scholarship Review Committee and shall be determined by the funds available and applications received.

Scholarship Recipient Criteria

As a fourteen-year veteran third grade teacher of Jupiter Christian School, and having worked with numerous families throughout her tenure, it was Donna's vision and desire to offer upon her passing a student scholarship. To honor her requests and to best memorialize her life, the Donna Bartz Memorial Scholarship will be awarded annually to the student(s) who best meet the following criteria:

- A student and family who desires a Christ-first education
- A student and family who is recommended by their pastor or church body
- A student and family who demonstrates a financial need and who would otherwise be unable to attend or afford Jupiter Christian School
- A student seeking enrollment in the elementary grades of 2nd through 6th grades currently located at the West Campus (main campus)
- A student who has been awarded the Donna Bartz Memorial Scholarship previously and who is transitioning to 7th grade or higher may be eligible to keep the scholarship based on review and approval by the Review Committee.
