### Focus on Him

#### Family Devotional

1. Ask your kids what the difference between a promise and a suggestion.
2. Is the first phrase of the verses a suggestion, an idea, a maybe statement, or a promise?

#### Isaiah 26:3-4 The Living Bible

He will keep in perfect peace all those who trust in him, whose thoughts turn often to the Lord! <sup>4</sup>Trust in the Lord God always, for in the Lord Jehovah is your everlasting strength.

#### Isaiah 26:3-4 ESV

You keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on you, because he trusts in you. Trust in the Lord forever, for the Lord God is an everlasting

3. Who is making the promise?
4. Why is who makes a promise important? Hint: does everyone keep their promise?
5. What promise does God make?
6. Yesterday we learned that if those who fear (worry or are anxious) pray fear will turn to peace. Today's verses tell us if our thoughts are on Him we will have perfect peace. Think about how we can keep our thought on God.
7. Here are some ideas I thought of: pray, read God's Word, focus on what He has done in the past, and think about His promises for the future. Start making a list. I'm sure it will get long. Talk about it as a family.
8. Keep memorizing Philippians 4:6 together. "Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything; tell God your needs, and don't forget to thank him for his answers."
9. Pray for your leaders. The president and vice president. National leaders. state leaders, and local leaders.
