"May the Lord bless you and take care of you; may the Lord be kind and gracious to you; may the Lord look on you with favor and give you peace." - Numbers 6:24-26


STATEMENT ON COVID-19 SCREENING OF STUDENTS, FACULTY & STAFF

All students, faculty, staff and administrators will be temperature checked at arrival **daily** by our on-campus nurses and clinic support staff. Any student, faculty or staff member with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will be sent home and asked to follow our JCS Response Plan.

This is a temporary policy in effect for the 2020-2021 academic year. The policy will be reevaluated throughout the semester and amended as appropriate.

JCS will continue to monitor and adhere to the CDC, AAP, federal and state standards, Palm Beach County Health Department guidelines, as well as ongoing recommendations from the Cleveland Clinic and Medical Advisory Committee.





VISITORS POLICY

Visitors will not be permitted on-campus during the academic day without an appointment scheduled in advance. Upon arrival all individuals will be subject to comply with JCS COVID-19 prescreening policies and safety procedures.

This policy will be amended when Palm Beach County has been moved into reopening phase three of the Palm Beach County Emergency Order.

JCS RESPONSE PLAN FOR COVID-19 ON CAMPUS ---

This chart is intended to provide an outlined response for Jupiter Christian School protocols that have been set in place to create a COVID-safe environment. In the event a student or faculty/staff member experiences symptoms or exposure to COVID-19, Jupiter Christian School will follow the advising of the Palm Beach County Health Department, CDC recommendations and Cleveland Clinic guidance.

Per the CDC, COVID-19 is mostly spread by respiratory droplets when people talk, cough or sneeze. At the point of this publication, the virus is believed to spread to hands from a contaminated surface and then to the nose or mouth, causing infection. Therefore, personal prevention practices (such as handwashing, staying home when sick, utilizing facial coverings and social distancing) can all deter the spread of COVID-19. **We encourage daily self-monitoring for our students, faculty and staff to be conducted prior to arriving on-campus, as a part of our JCS Community Pledge agreement.**

The table below defines the JCS response to on-campus COVID-19 scenarios. "Exposure" is determined based on the surrounding factors to a positive case. Per the CDC, TRUE exposure to COVID-19 has been defined as:

- Both individuals are not utilizing PPE, AND
- Within six feet of each other, AND
- Exposed to a positive COVID-19 person for 15 minutes or greater

Please read through the table below to understand the JCS response. General policies applicable to all scenarios include:

- A doctor's clearance note is required for return-to-campus, following any illness.
- Students will participate in the Virtual Classroom Learning option for 2nd thru 12th grade, while they are completing required isolation.
- Individual's identity will not be disclosed in any parent/campus communication.

EAST CAMPUS

Policy on Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Protecting East Campus Students

Students will be temperature screened prior to entering campus. Teachers and campus nurses will assist with facilitating this daily practice to provide a level of comfort for our younger students. Any student whose temperature reaches or exceeds 100.4, will be sent to the nurses' clinic where they will be isolated from other students and observed. Parents will be required to pick-up their student immediately. We do ask that your family conduct the Daily Home Screening exercises before arrival on-campus.

Outside classroom spaces will be maximized this year to greatly reduce the amount of indoor activities. Children will be reminded frequently to wash their hands and students will remain with their cohort of students throughout the day. Staff, faculty and administrators will be required to wear facial coverings when social distancing is not an option. All faculty and staff are being provided clear style masks to aid and improve communication. At this point in time, facial coverings are a recommendation for our east campus JCS students.

We understand the ages of our students may not always be compatible with the requirements and recommendations made by public health organizations and healthcare professionals. We are educators and will continue to prioritize the social well-being, mental and spiritual development of our young students. We ask for your continued grace and parent partnership as navigate uncharted territory in a temporary environment.

Orientation and Meet the Teacher

We are looking forward to your student joining us on-campus very soon. Please be expecting our call Monday, August 3rd or Tuesday, August 4th. Teachers will be contacting families directly to introduce themselves and schedule an in-person visit to our East Campus, Teacher Meet & Greet. Individual appointments will be scheduled in 10-minute increments, and we are asking attendance be limited to parents and students. Parents, please wear a facial covering and enter through:

- **Preschool** families enter the South gate
- **Kindergarten & 1st Grade** families enter the North gate

School Lunch Services

In line with our community promise and to remain COVID-safe, JCS will be temporarily discontinuing hot lunch and cafeteria services. Students will be required to bring their temperature controlled, boxed lunches (refrigerators and microwaves will be temporarily unavailable). Outside deliveries (restaurant, UberEats, GrubHub, etc.) will not be accepted on-campus.

Lunches will rotate between the outside courtyard and classroom space. Students who are UV-ray sensitive will have the choice to eat inside

We are working with outside vendors to provide pre-packaged, fresh meal delivery service later in the semester to our students, faculty and staff. More information will be directly communicated with families after the beginning of school.

Drop-off and Pick-up

Drop-off and pick-up will be conducted with a staggered schedule. Students will be prescreened prior to entering campus gates. Students who temp over 100.4 will be isolated in the nurses clinic and parents will be contacted immediately for pick-up.

1st Grade drop-off will begin at 8:00 a.m. at the north carline

PK4 car line will begin at 7:45 a.m. at the south carline

PK3 car line will begin at 8:00 a.m. at the south carline

PK2 students may be brought to the classroom door

*Siblings will follow the youngest siblings schedule for drop off.

Pick-up Times:

Kindergarten student pick-up will begin at 2:40 p.m. at the north carline

1st Grade student pick-up will begin at 2:50 p.m.

PK2 student (without siblings) pick-up at 2:30 p.m.

PK4 student pick-up will begin at 2:40 p.m.

PK3 student pick-up will begin at 2:50 p.m.

Ways to Make Morning Carline Operate Smoothly for PK3 & PK4:

- Please stay in the car at carline
- Please have all items ready when car reaches drop off point
- Please prepare your child by saying good bye, hugs and kisses prior to dropping point

Ways to make Afternoon Carline Operate Smoothly:

- If you arrive prior to dismissal time, please park across the street in the church parking lot
- Please stay in your car at carline
- "Pull up to buckle up" (for PK2-PK4). Please pull up to flag pole to buckle your child safely, prior to exiting the parking lot

LOWER SCHOOL

Policy on Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Pick-up will be in the back carline by the gym.

Students who are not picked up by 3:00pm will be signed in to extended care.

Drop-off and Student Parking

Drop-off

Upper School students should arrive at school between 7:20 and 7:40 a.m. each day to provide enough time for student prescreening procedures. The late bell will ring at 7:50 a.m. In every effort to provide the necessary daily adjustments for facial covering breaks, additional cleaning and sanitation, and maximum instructional time without extending the academic year; **late start Wednesdays have been temporarily removed for the 2020-2021 academic year.**

Students should be dropped off by the black awning near our gymnasium entrance. Upon arrival, all students will have their temperatures checked prior to entering the building. Any student with a temperature over 100.4 degrees will not be permitted to stay and will need to be picked up IMMEDIATELY.

Student Parking

Juniors and Seniors can register for a general parking permit during the first week of school. Parking spots are available for seniors to paint at for \$150. Proceeds will go toward designated senior student activities. All designs will need to be approved by administration prior to decorating. Email mwinters@jupiterchristian.org for registration link.

Locker Supplies

Technical Devices

“Bring Your Own Device”

Our teaching and learning approach will look different this year to best support students and families in a face-to-face and virtual classroom as well as potential transitions between the two learning environments. Students and teachers will primarily utilize Portal, Office 365 (Forms, Word, PowerPoint, OneNote), and Zoom for communication, collaboration, and content delivery/creation (including assignment submissions).

As teachers demonstrate and require these digital learning tools, it is strongly recommended that 7th-12th grade students bring their own device to utilize at home and while in class. Approved specifications for devices: Chromebook, Macbook Pro. Preferred Web Browser: Chrome.

JCS COVID-19 ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK WAIVER

Jupiter Christian School has taken proactive measures to operate in a COVID-safe environment. While our policies may be adjusted to reflect local health guidelines available at the date of operation, it is important families opting into on-campus learning this academic year, understand they are entering a facility that has open enrollment to the public and there is an inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and individuals with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable.
