Student-Athlete Transportation Release Form 2023-24

It is expected all student-athletes will travel with the team to and from athletic contests or off-campus practices and return with the team in the school provided bus. There are several reasons for this procedure, but foremost are safety, security, and legal liability. We recognize there are exceptions of extenuating circumstances that may be approved by the Athletic Director.

EXCEPTION: Student-Athletes must have approval from the coach and a completed transportation release form in the Athletic Office prior to the scheduled event departure if they are not riding the provided transportation to and/or from an athletic practice or game. The Coach must personally release the student-athlete and may only release the student-athlete to the parent/legal guardian. <u>Student-athletes may not</u> <u>transport another student-athlete and are not permitted to be released without this completed form.</u>
